

1. General: Purpose and Acceptance of Terms and Conditions

General. Your use of the Global Alzheimer's Platform Foundation (GAP) Memory Strings web portal (the "Registry Portal") and the services associated with the Registry Portal (the "Services") is governed by the following terms and conditions herein (the "Terms and Conditions") and a privacy policy (the "Privacy Policy"), both of which you must read before using the Registry Portal. All pages within the Registry Portal are owned and operated by the Global Alzheimer's Platform Foundation. (dba "GAP").

b. Purpose. The purpose of the Registry Portal (and its backend database) is to allow its users to easily find matching clinical trials and participating research organizations potential participants for clinical trials and research studies in the treatment and understanding of Alzheimer's Disease.

c. Acceptance of Terms and Conditions. By using the Registry Portal, you represent that you accept and agree that you have read all of the Terms and Conditions and the Privacy Policy, understand them, and that you agree to and have the legal capacity to be bound by them.

These Terms and Conditions constitute a legal agreement between you and GAP. GAP reserves the right to modify these Terms and Conditions at any time in its sole discretion, and without prior notice, by posting amended terms on this Registry Portal. We encourage you to review the Terms and Conditions periodically for any updates or changes. If you do not agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions and the Privacy Policy, you may not use the Registry Portal.

2. Ownership

a. All GAP generated content available at the Registry Portal, including without limitation, any information, software, photographs, images, video, audio, graphics, or text on the Registry Portal ("Content"), and all patent, copyright, trademark, trade dress, domain name, trade secret, and other proprietary rights therein are the sole property of GAP or used by GAP with the permission of the owner of such content. IN EXCHANGE FOR THE RIGHT TO ACCESS GAP'S REGISTRY PORTAL, YOU EXPRESSLY AGREE NOT TO SELL, LICENSE, DISCLOSE, POST, PUBLISH, DISPLAY OR OTHERWISE TRANSFER THE DE-IDENTIFIED PATIENT DATA OR CLINICAL TRIAL INFORMATION TO ANY THIRD PARTY WITHOUT THE PRIOR EXPRESS WRITTEN CONSENT OF GAP.

THE DE-IDENTIFIED PATIENT DATA AND THE CLINICAL TRIAL INFORMATION SHALL NOT BE (A) DISCLOSED DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY BY YOU TO ANY THIRD PARTY, OR (B) USED BY YOU FOR ANY COMMERCIAL PURPOSE WHATSOEVER.

YOU WILL BE LIABLE FOR UNAUTHORIZED USE OR DISCLOSURE OF DE-IDENTIFIED PATIENT DATA OR CLINICAL TRIAL INFORMATION BY YOU OR YOUR AFFILIATES' OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS OR COLLABORATION PARTNER(S) (AS THE CASE MAY BE).

YOU ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE THAT UNAUTHORIZED USE OR DISCLOSURE OF DE-IDENTIFIED PATIENT DATA OR CLINICAL TRIAL INFORMATION BY YOU MAY CAUSE GAP IRREPARABLE HARM, AND THEREFORE AGREE THAT GAP WILL BE ENTITLED TO SEEK EXTRAORDINARY RELIEF IN COURT, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDERS, PRELIMINARY INJUNCTIONS AND PERMANENT INJUNCTIONS WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF POSTING A BOND OR OTHER SECURITY AND IN ADDITION TO AND WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO ANY OTHER RIGHTS OR REMEDIES THAT GAP MAY HAVE FOR A BREACH OF THIS AGREEMENT.
